RULES



1. N.O.H.A. rules will apply throughout the tournament.
2. No player will be permitted to play for more than one team (in the same division) during the tournament.
3. Games in the peewee division will consist of three 10 minute stop time periods. Games in the bantam division will consist of three 12 minute stop time periods. There will be no overtime in preliminary games. In the Championship games the third period will be 15-minute stop time. When required in the Championship, semi-final and quarterfinal games, overtime will be played in 10-minute stop time periods until a goal is scored.
4. Standings within the division will be based on the results of the games played. Points will be awarded as follows:

Win	=	3 points
Tie	=	2 points
Loss	=	1 point
Default	=	0 points
5. In the event of a tie at the end of preliminary play the following procedure will apply:
 - 1) In the event that two teams are tied, the winner of the game between those two teams, if they played each other, will take the higher standing. If three teams are tied, a team with a 2-0 record against tied teams (if they played each other) will take the higher standing.
 - 2) If, still tied, then the team with the most wins takes the higher position.
 - 3) If, still tied, then the team with the best goal average will take the higher position (N. O. H. A. FORMULA). In the event a tie exists between three or more teams, the goal average will determine the position of all tied teams.
 - 4) If still tied the team with least goals scored against would take the higher position.
 - 5) If still tied the team receiving the least number of penalty minutes in there three games played would take the higher position.
 - 6) If still tied, a single toss of a coin will determine the higher position.
6. Division and playoff format will be set up once the number of teams is determined.
7. The committee reserves the right to change the playoff format of any division in order to balance playoff caliber.
8. Protests must be submitted in writing within one hour of completion of the game being protested. A deposit of \$200.00 must accompany each protest. The deposit would be returned if the protest is upheld and forfeited if the protest is denied.
